

Wall of Distinction

Barriere Secondary School created a “Wall of Distinction” in 2009 to recognize past Barriere students that have made a significant contribution or achieved outstanding status in their chosen fields of endeavour.

Criteria for Nominations:

- a) Attended schools in Barriere for 5 years or graduated from Barriere Secondary.
- b) International, National, Provincial or educational recognition in chosen fields of endeavour.
- c) If a candidate is not selected in one year, they are considered for another year.
- d) An educator or principal could be considered if the committee felt they had contributed extraordinarily.
- e) Cap the selection at a minimum of 3 selected for 5 years and then one or two per year.
- f) A book with resumes to be started for those chosen for distinction. This would include information about individuals, their achievements and other material that could not be included on the wall plaque.

The areas for recognition are academics, athletics, arts, humanitarian activities or in government, industry or labour.
